Grounds: Sandhills Wildlife Area, Hoffman, NC.

Qualification: Entry must have a placement in a recognized Amateur Shooting Dog or Amateur Derby stake and must be an individual AFTCA member to enter your dog. One-hour braces. No live ammunition permitted on grounds during trial.

Only a solid barrel or plugged barrel firearm, with blank shells or crimps, which prevents a projectile (of any kind) from leaving the barrel may be used. .32 caliber blanks or larger will be fired over dogs on point.

Handlers' Dinner: Immediately following the last brace of the day, Saturday, February 17. Lunches will be provided daily.

All horses must have negative coggins test within the last year—certificate required.
