Grounds & Directions: From I-86, Exit 36, south on Hwy. 37, immediately and directly across the highway from Pioneer Equipment take Ferry Hollow Rd. After approx. $\frac{3}{4}$ mile, Ferry Hollow Rd. bends sharply 160 degrees back on itself circling the home on the right—do not go straight or take the driveway that is the available 90 degree turn. Stay on Ferry Hollow Rd. approx. another $\frac{3}{4}$ mile to the field trial headquarters area located to the right of the road. Conditions are extremely dry and the cover very tall this year—please allow vehicles to cool as much as possible in the roadway or stubble field prior to parking in the tall grass adjacent to the stubble field. Absolutely no smoking, live fire, or other incendiaries allowed on grounds.

Courses: Championships to be contested on 6 one-hour courses of CRP grasses with mixed sage patches linked by rolling hills and draws, home to native sharptails, huns and pheasants. **Meals:** Daily lunches and a hosted dinner Friday evening on the grounds. EIBDC hosting a Saturday night dinner at Indian Springs Resort & RV, near grounds, at 6:30 P.M. **Motels:** Available in American Falls, Pocatello, and Chubbuck.
