**Grounds & Directions:** From I-86, Exit 36, south on Hwy. 37, immediately and directly across the highway from Pioneer Equipment take Ferry Hollow Rd. After approx.  $\frac{3}{4}$  mile, Ferry Hollow Rd. bends sharply 160 degrees back on itself circling the home on the right—do not go straight or take the driveway that is the available 90 degree turn. Stay on Ferry Hollow Rd. approx. another 4.2 miles to the field trial headquarters area located to the left of the road. Camping is available on the grounds in the stubble field confiend within area as marked. Camping also available approx. 15 minutes away (for self shuttle to and from grounds daily) at Power County Fairgrounds with camping, water and stabling/staking out horses and dogs. **Courses:** Championship to be contested on 3 one-hour “continuous at road crossings” courses of CRP grasses with mixed sage patches linked by rolling hills and aspen lined draws, home to native forest grouse, sharptails, huns and pheasants.
